Household Hazardous Waste Collection

Open every Tuesday and Friday from Noon to 3:30 p.m. at the City of San Marcos Traffic Yard — 630 E. Hopkins, San Marcos, TX
512-393-8440 Open Rain or Shine!

(The San Marcos Traffic Yard is across the street from the big HEB in San Marcos)

Acceptable: A maximum of 10 5-gallon buckets, drain cleaners, concentrates, degreasers, oven cleaners, pool chemicals, household batteries, latex and oil paints, spray paints, thinners, strippers, preservatives, brush cleaners, pesticides, antifreeze, vehicle batteries, motor oil and oil filters, brake fluid, transmission fluid, compact fluorescent bulbs and fluorescent lights.

Not Acceptable: More than 10 5-gallon buckets, tires, medical waste, containers larger than 5 gallons, empty containers, pharmaceuticals, compressed gas cylinders or waste generated by businesses.

Transport your hazardous waste safely: Do not combine chemicals ♦ Keep products in original containers ♦ If containers are leaking place the waste in a like container ♦ Transport your hazardous waste in the trunk of your vehicle, not in the passenger compartment ♦
